<u>IN THE CASE OF INGESTION</u> Seek medical attention immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Rinse mouth with water.			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH SKIN</u> Wash skin with plenty of soap and warm water. Seek medical advice if irritation persists.

<u>IN THE CASE OF INGESTION</u> Give plenty of water to rinse mouth and to drink. Take casualty to hospital if necessary.			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH SKIN</u> Wash skin with plenty of soap and warm water. Remove contaminated clothing.			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH EYES</u> Flush the eyes for 10 minutes with clean running water. Seek medical advice if symptoms persist.			
<u>AFTER INHALATION</u> Remove to fresh air and keep casualty warm and at rest. Take to hospital if breathing difficulties occur.			
OTHER INFORMATION In contact with water (or sweat), cement becomes strongly alkaline and able to cause burns and ulcers. As nerve endings may be damaged, burning may not be felt.			
PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT TO BE WORN Impervious gloves to be worn for prolonged contact.			
STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS Store in lockable area at ambient temperature.

<u>IN CONTACT WITH SKIN</u> Remove contaminated clothing; wash affected area with plenty of soap and water; do not use solvents or thinners			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH EYES</u> Flush the eyes for 15 minutes with clean running water. Take casualty to hospital if adverse reaction occurs.			
<u>AFTER INHALATION</u> Remove to fresh air and keep casualty warm and at rest. Take to hospital if breathing difficulties occur.			
OTHER INFORMATION Do not smoke or use near naked flame.

<u>AFTER INHALATION</u> Remove to fresh air and keep casualty warm and at rest. Take to hospital if breathing difficulties occur.

<u>IN THE CASE OF INGESTION</u> Take casualty to hospital. Do not induce vomiting.			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH SKIN</u> Wash skin with plenty of warm water and soap. Remove contaminated clothing.			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH EYES</u> Flush the eyes for 15 minutes with clean running water.			
<u>AFTER INHALATION</u> Remove to fresh air and keep casualty warm and at rest. Take to hospital if breathing difficulties occur.			
OTHER INFORMATION Use in a well ventilated area.			
PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT TO BE WORN Gloves and safety glasses to be worn.

<u>IN THE CASE OF INGESTION</u> Give plenty of water to rinse mouth and to drink. Do not induce vomiting.			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH SKIN</u> Wash skin with plenty of warm water and remove contaminated clothing.			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH EYES</u> Flush the eyes for 20 minutes with clean running water. Take casualty to hospital immediately – SPEED IS IMPORTANT.			
<u>AFTER INHALATION</u> Irrigate the throat and nose for 20 mins with clean running water. Take casualty to hospital.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT TO BE WORN Gloves and goggles when mixing or using large quantities. Barrier cream to be used as a defence.

TYPE OF HAZARD – IRRITANT			
EMERGENCY ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN			
<u>IN THE CASE OF INGESTION</u> Seek medical attention immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Rinse mouth with water.			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH SKIN</u> Wash skin with plenty of soap and warm water.			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH EYES</u> Flush the eyes for 15 minutes with clean running water.			
<u>AFTER INHALATION</u> Remove to fresh air and keep casualty warm and at rest. Take to hospital if breathing difficulties occur.			
OTHER INFORMATION Wash hands after use.			
PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT TO BE WORN Overalls, rubber or PVC gloves, and goggles if splashing is likely to occur.

<u>IN CONTACT WITH SKIN</u> Wash skin with plenty of water. Remove contaminated clothing. Do not use solvents or thinners.			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH EYES</u> Flush the eyes for 10 minutes with clean running water. Seek medical advice.			
<u>AFTER INHALATION</u> Remove to fresh air and keep casualty warm and at rest. Take to hospital if breathing difficulties occur.			
OTHER INFORMATION

<u>IN CONTACT WITH SKIN</u> Remove contaminated clothing; wash affected area with plenty of soap and water; do not use solvents or thinners			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH EYES</u> Flush the eyes for 10 minutes with clean running water. Take casualty to hospital.			
<u>AFTER INHALATION</u> Remove to fresh air and keep casualty warm and at rest. Take to hospital if breathing difficulties occur.			
OTHER INFORMATION Do not smoke or use near naked flame. Use in a well ventilated area.			
PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT TO BE WORN Overalls and gloves if prolonged or repeated exposure. Goggles if splashing is likely to occur.

<u>IN THE CASE OF INGESTION</u> Give plenty of milk or water to rinse mouth and to drink. Take casualty to hospital. Do not induce vomiting.			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH SKIN</u> Wash skin with plenty of warm water and soap.			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH EYES</u> Flush the eyes for 15 minutes with clean running water. Take casualty to hospital immediately.			
<u>AFTER INHALATION</u> Remove to fresh air and keep casualty warm and at rest. Take to hospital if breathing difficulties occur.			
OTHER INFORMATION Avoid breathing vapours – use in a well ventilated area.			
PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT TO BE WORN Where goggles when using above head height. Overalls and gloves to be worn.			
STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS Store in a cool, dark area, away from sunlight, heat or ignition sources. Keep container closed when not in use.			
SAFETY OFFICERS ANNUAL REVIEW (COMPLIANCE WITH STORAGE, TRAINING, PPE, USAGE)

TYPE OF HAZARD – HARMFUL			
EMERGENCY ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN			
<u>IN THE CASE OF INGESTION</u> Do not induce vomiting. Keep at rest and obtain urgent medical attention.			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH SKIN</u> Remove contaminated clothing; wash affected area with plenty of soap and water; do not use solvents or thinners			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH EYES</u> Flush the eyes for 10 minutes with clean running water. Take casualty to hospital.			
<u>AFTER INHALATION</u> Remove to fresh air and keep casualty warm and at rest. Take to hospital if breathing difficulties occur.			
OTHER INFORMATION Wash hands after use. Ensure adequate ventilation when applying.			
PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT TO BE WORN Overalls and gloves if prolonged or repeated exposure. Goggles if splashing is likely to occur.			
STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS Store in an original tin in a cool, dark area, away from sunlight, heat or ignition sources. Keep container closed

<u>IN CONTACT WITH SKIN</u> Wash skin with plenty of warm water and soap. Remove contaminated clothing.			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH EYES</u> Flush the eyes for 15 minutes with clean running water. Seek medical advice if irritation persists.			
<u>AFTER INHALATION</u> Remove casualty to fresh air, keep warm and at rest.			
OTHER INFORMATION Do not smoke while using. Do not use near a naked flame.			
PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT TO BE WORN			
STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS Store upright in original closed container in a cool place, away from heat and ignition sources.

<u>IN CONTACT WITH SKIN</u> Wash with soap and water.			
<u>IN CONTACT WITH EYES</u> Flush the eyes for 10 minutes with clean running water. Seek medical advice.			
<u>AFTER INHALATION</u> Remove to fresh air and keep casualty warm and at rest. Take to hospital if breathing difficulties occur.			
OTHER INFORMATION Use in a well ventilated area. No smoking.			
PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT TO BE WORN Respiratory equipment if prolonged usage expected, or if ventilation cannot be improved.

<u>IN CONTACT WITH EYES</u> Flush the eyes for 10 minutes with clean running water. Take casualty to hospital if discomfort persists.			
<u>AFTER INHALATION</u> Remove to fresh air and keep casualty warm and at rest. Take to hospital if breathing difficulties occur.			
OTHER INFORMATION Do not mix with any material other than water.
